#### Variety description

MARIANNE is a bird's-foot trefoil that flowers in mid-season and has a very high yield potential. The yields are evenly distributed throughout the year. Its high crude protein content means that it also produces high protein yields. MARIANNE is characterised by its high persistence and good winter-hardiness – a fact evident from the yields in the second year and the relatively low deficiency after the second winter.

#### Most important characteristics

Very high-yielding

High yield potential throughout the year

Extremely high persistence and winter-hardiness

Low susceptibility to diseases

**Usage** 

Bird's-foot trefoil is a very good ingredient in mixtures for dry locations. It does particularly well on limestone soils.
