Variety description

STRUCTURATOR freezes over winter, leaving deep holes in the ground. The roots can reach depths of over 70 cm and loosen compacted soil. It can thus break up even difficult ground sections, such as plough sole, and significantly improve the tilth. Water penetrating the soil can freeze during subsequent frosts and expand over large areas. This frost impact

helps to loosen the soil. Flail mowing in autumn encourages this loosening of the soil mechanically.
