Variety description

TITICACA is a variety in the medium maturity group. It is distinguished by relatively rapid early development, which contributes to its ability to form stands effectively. TITICACA grows to an average height, with limited branching and a terminal infructescence. This results in a very homogeneous stand and uniform ripening. In addition, TITICACA is very stable and demonstrates a high level of disease tolerance.
