

SAGANE is a special hybrid ryegrass, bred with the most important lawn grass segment. SAGANE is a special hybrid ryegrass, bred with the most important lawn grass qualities in mind. It combines the important lawn grass characteristics of perennial ryegrass with the extremely quick stand establishment and rapid growth characteristics of Italian ryegrass all in one variety. At the same time, SAGANE forms a uniform and compact sward, and is quite hard-wearing. SAGANE lasts at least two years and clearly stands out against conventional annual ryegrasses which are sometimes used in grass mixtures for appropriate regeneration measures or to help in stand establishment.
