Variety description

VERLIGHT is a French tall fescue variety. In addition, VERLIGHT is the first variety with quality characteristics that indicate top genetic traits as well as a medium-green colouration. Many other tall fescue varieties have a considerably darker green shade, which makes their use in mixtures tricky in terms of achieving a balanced, uniform look. Not so with VERLIGHT. What is more, VERLIGHT scores extra points for its formidable hardiness, excellent sward density and high disease tolerance. VERLIGHT is an excellent choice for both hard-wearing and recreational lawns, especially when used in lawn mixes for dry conditions.
