Pest control and rodent prevention

for seed in retail spaces

Basic information:

Mouse populations increase exponentially. A single breeding pair can grow to a population of over 1 million mice within a single year. Like all animals, mice need water to survive. Healthy mice are extremely fast and agile. Rodents can eat through practically any material, including paper, cardboard, polyethylene sheets, insulation, polystyrene and drywall.

Preventive measures:

- Cleanliness in the retail premises
 - In garden centres and divisions for animal feed or small animals, it is extremely important to carry out regular inventory control and remove opened seed packaging and broken goods, as well as immediately clear rubbish and leftover seed and food products
- Low stocks of goods and regular restocking
- To avoid quiet spaces in the retail area, all prominently displayed goods in areas with high customer traffic and visibility should be spread across the sales floor as evenly as possible
- Eliminate any hideaway spots for rodents (e.g. holes in walls and openings in false ceilings, cavities and undisturbed, dark corners)
- Boxes and containers are only to be used if they can be completely closed, otherwise they should be avoided
- Snap or cage traps
