Variety description

CERETEC CENTURION is a perennial ryegrass variety from among the cool season offer. It exhibits high winter activity, which ensures a fine green colour at the beginning of the growing season and throughout the year. CERETEC CENTURION also displays good tolerance to low cutting. Thanks to its good sward density, this variety is especially suited to recreational and hard-wearing lawns, while its competitive vigour allows for its usage in analogous reseeding mixtures.
