

### Variety description

Thanks to its excellent quality, BELLEVUE perennial ryegrass is among the higher-end lawn grass varieties. Its good sward density and high durability are particularly noteworthy characteristics. They make this variety a good candidate for both recreational and hard-wearing lawns, with a grade of 8 (extremely suitable) in the German classification of lawn seed mixtures, or RSM. BELLVUE is also characterised by a considerable level of weed suppression due to these factors. Its medium-green colouration makes this competitive variety suitable for reseeding in existing lawns.
