#### Variety description

BORLUNA is a variety of slender creeping red fescue, which is universally suitable for use in nearly all lawn types. It forms a very thick sward and is also very good at withstanding deep cuts. BORLUNA is also not particularly susceptible to rot and exhibits a marked ability to suppress weeds. The variety is distinguished by its medium to dark green colouration, intermediate drought resistance and noteworthy tolerance of shade.

**Usage** With its short stolons, slender creeping red fescue shares several

> characteristics with Chewing's fescue, though its better drought resistance, ability to tolerate being cut short, and somewhat better salt tolerance make

it stand out from the rest.
