Variety description

BAQUEANO is a well-balanced annual ryegrass variety with medium yields that are most pronounced at the first cut. BAQUEANO demonstrates a low susceptibility to lodging and medium disease resistance.

Usage

Annual ryegrass belongs to the family of short-lived ryegrass, because it puts forth shoots in the year of sowing. Annual ryegrass is bred for two purposes: 1. Catch crop cultivation after cereal harvest; 2. Annual arable feed crop production with multiple cuts, sometimes also in combination with Italian ryegrass
